### What you need:

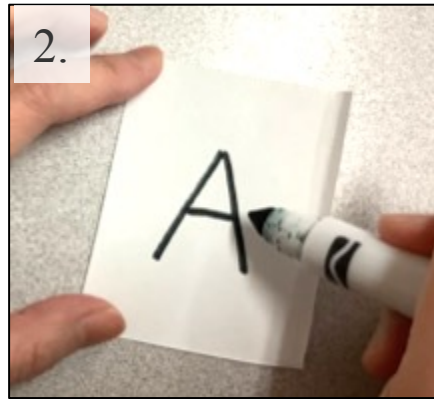
- Markers

- Construction Paper (2 different colours)



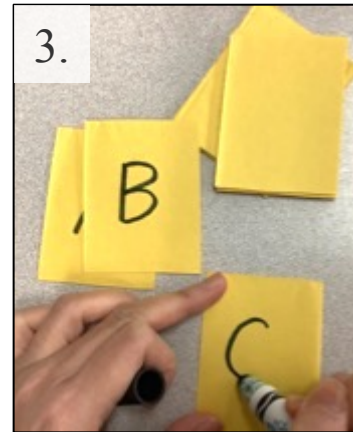
### Steps:



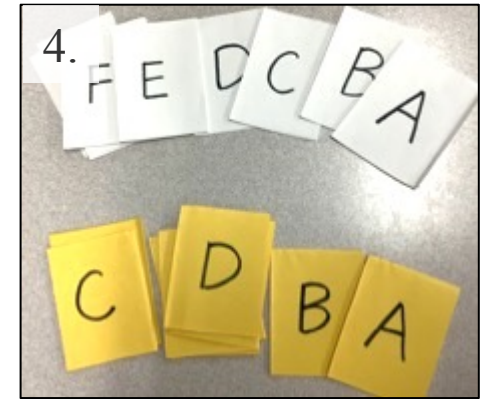
1. Cut both coloured construction paper into palm-sized squares.



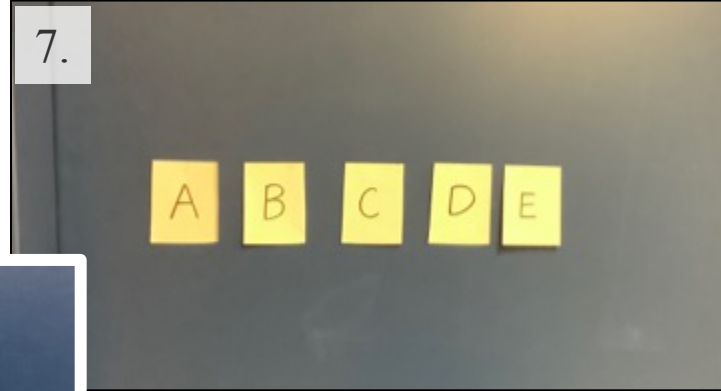
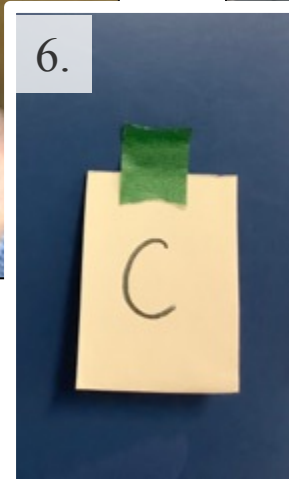
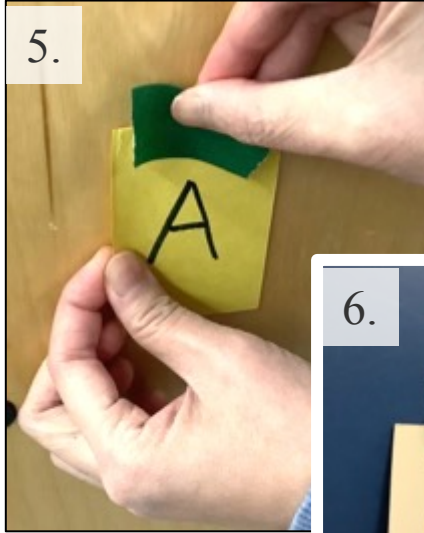
2. Write a letter of the alphabet on each square of white paper.



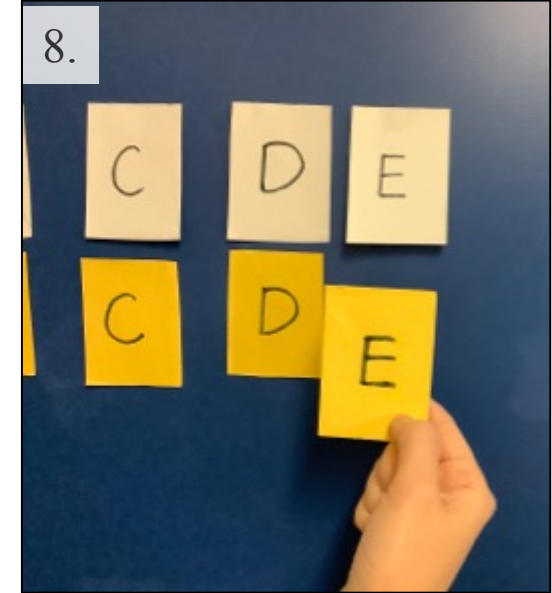
3. Write a letter of the alphabet on each square of yellow paper.



4. Separate the construction paper squares by their colour.



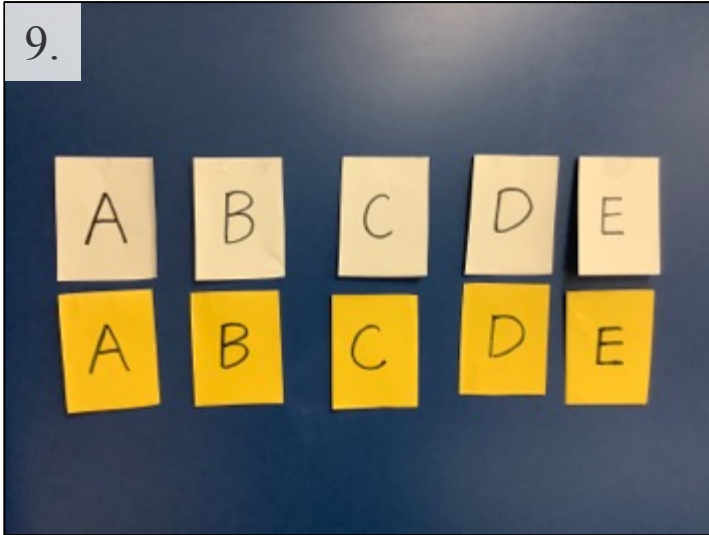
7. Tape the letters on the white construction paper along a wall.



8. With your child, find the yellow paper squares around the house, and match them underneath the white papers along the wall.

5, 6. Tape the letters on the yellow construction paper around the house, where your child can look for them.

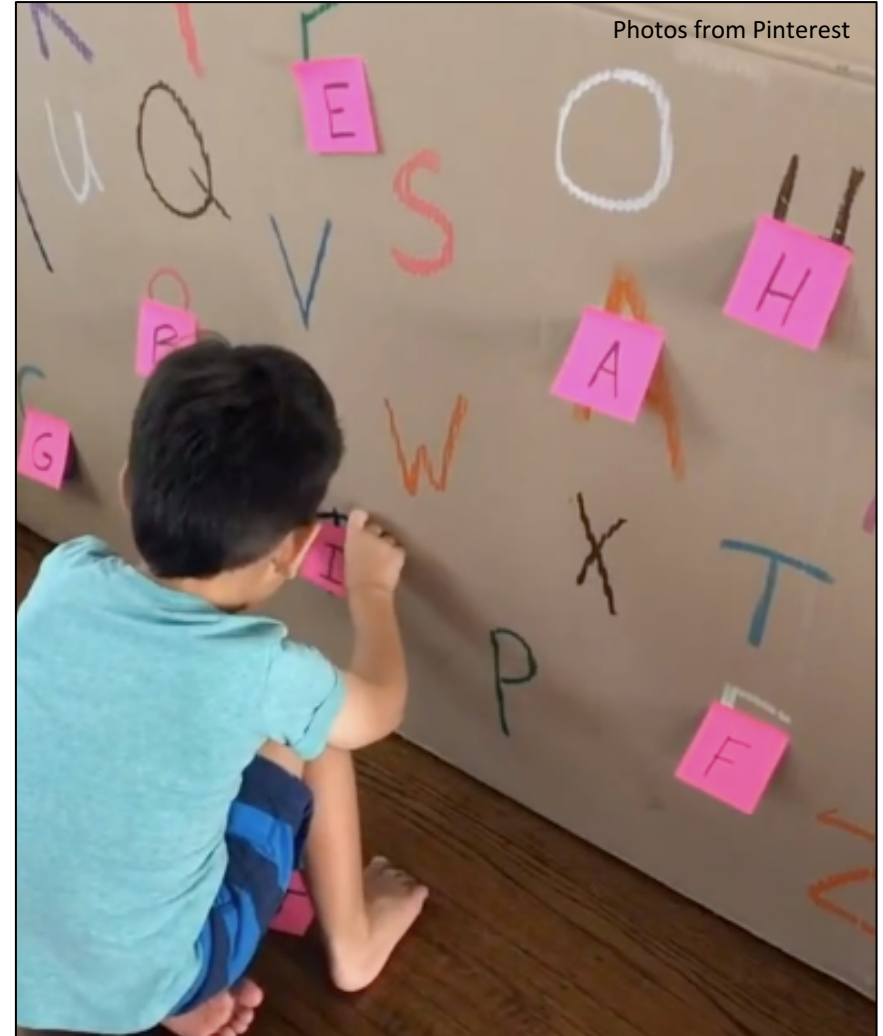

9. Find and match all the letters with your child.
