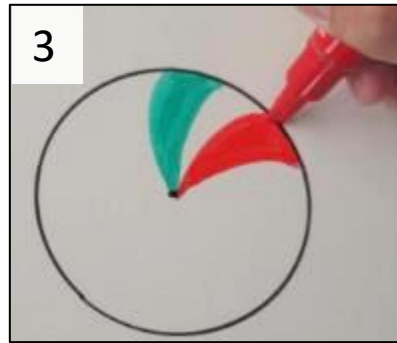
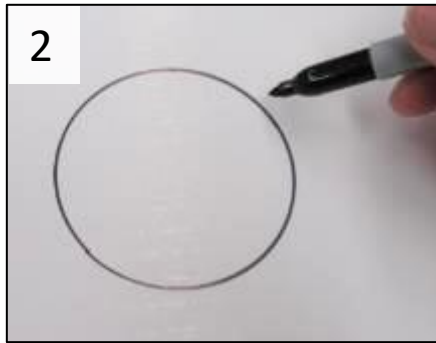


## COIN SPINNER

### Steps:



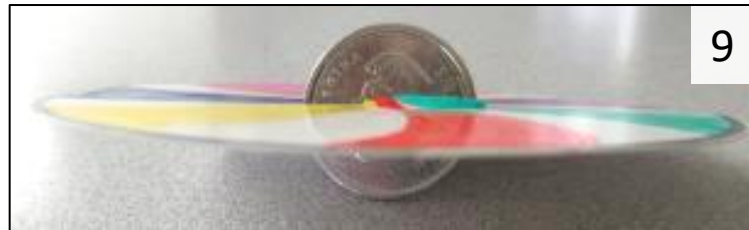
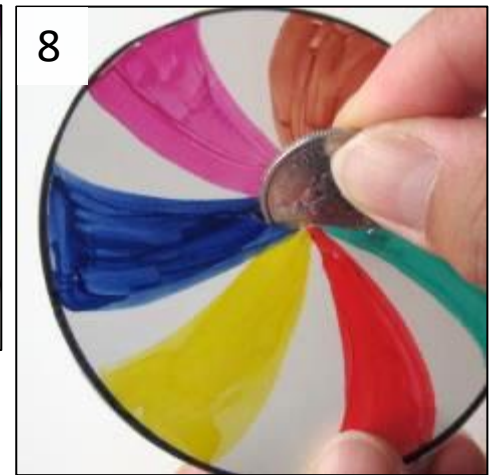
1, 2. Using a cup and a black marker, trace a circle onto a sheet of white paper.

3, 4. With the black marker, make a small dot in the middle of the circle. Using colorful markers, decorate the inside of the circle with some patterns and designs.

### What you need:

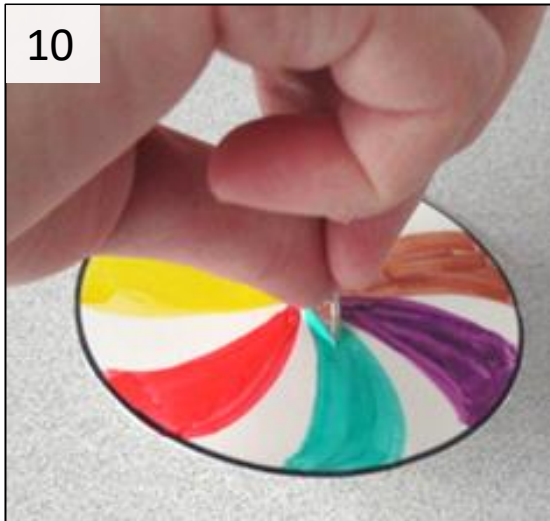
- Scissors
- Markers
- A Cup
- White construction paper
- A Box Cutter
- A Coin (Loonie or Toonie)





5, 6. Cut out the circle using the scissors, then using the dot as a reference, cut a small slit in the middle of the circle using a box cutter.

7, 8, 9. Push a coin into the slit gently, to avoid making a larger tear into the paper. Push it through so that each half of the coin is exposed on either side of the circle.



10, 11, 12. Placing the circle down so that one edge of the coin is against a flat surface, twist the coin as if turning a key, but with a bit more force. At that moment, let go of the coin to watch the paper spin, along with the coin. With your child, look at how the appearance of the designs change as it moves swiftly around the flat surface.
