Counting Dots and Marching Numbers


What you need




- Pen or Marker
- Scissors
- White and coloured construction paper

Steps

- 1. Cut both white and coloured construction paper into squares
- 2. Write a number on the white paper, from one to ten. 3. Draw the dots on the coloured paper. Match the number of dots to the number on the white paper









Steps

- 4. Group the dot papers by their colour
- 5. Match the dot papers to the number papers

*When you are done, count the numbers with your child! *Parent could ask: "What number is this?" "Let's find where there are 5 dots." "Let's count how many dots you have."
