


COUNTING DOTS AND MATCHING NUMBERS

☐ What you need:

- Pen or Marker
- Scissors
- White and coloured construction paper





1. Cut both white and coloured construction paper into squares.

- 2. Write a number on the white paper, from one to ten.
- 3. Draw the dots on the coloured paper. Match the number of dots to the number on the white paper.

4. 1 2 3 4 5 6 1 8



- 4. Group the dot papers by their colour.
- 5. Match the dot papers to the number papers.
- *When you are done, count the numbers with your child!
- *Parent could ask:
 - "What number is this?"
 - "Let's find where there are 5 dots."
 - "Let's count how many dots you have."
