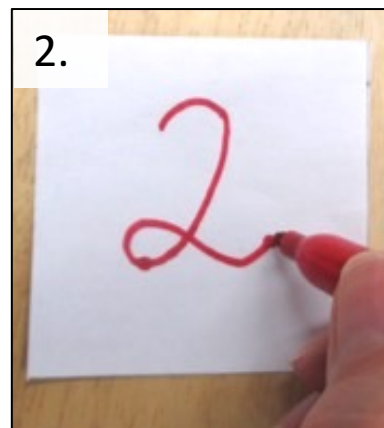
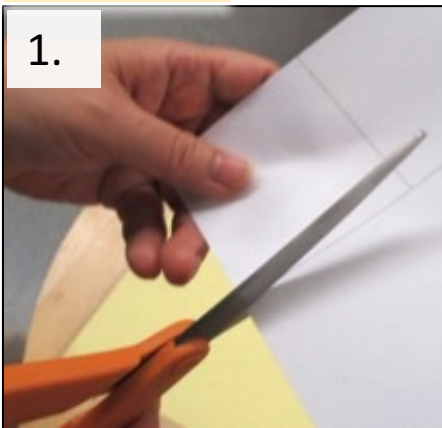

Steps:



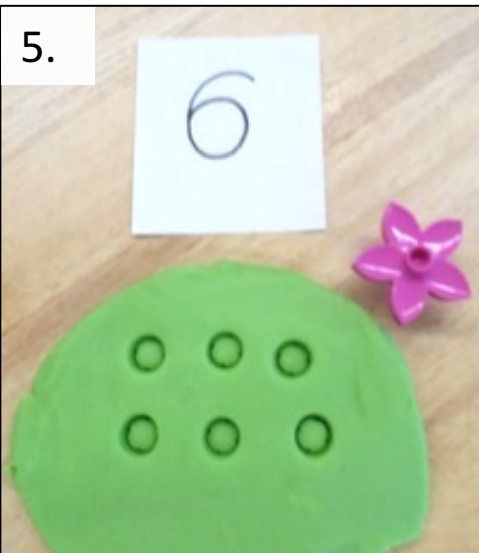
1. Cut paper into squares.
2. Write down a number on each square.
3. Prepare some Lego blocks, the number squares, the roller and the playdough.

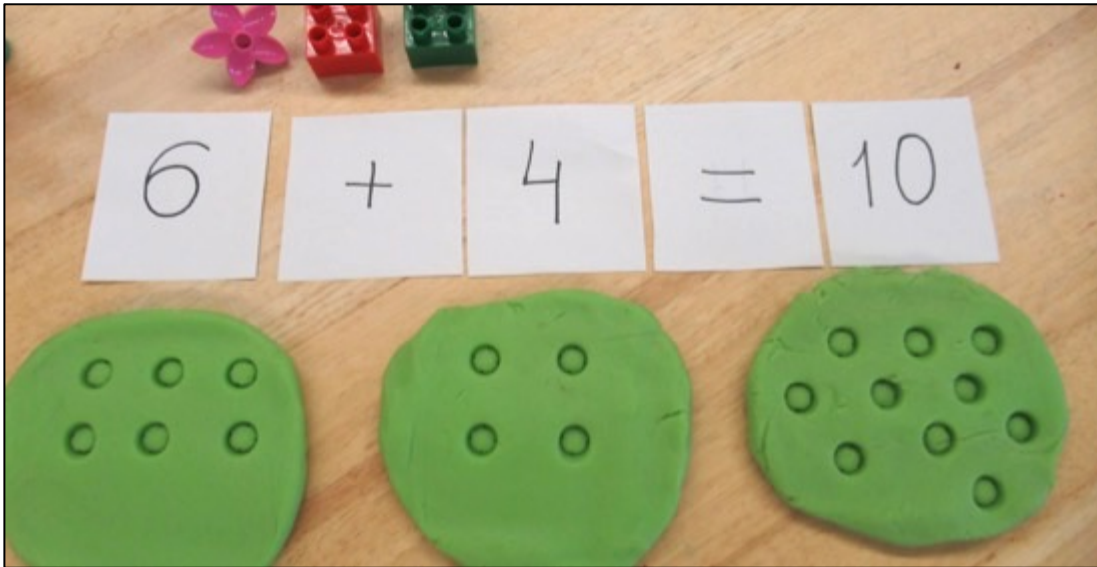
4. Pick a number square and place it next to a piece of playdough.
