

Finding colour




What you need

- Clothespins
- Glue
- Scissors
- Color Paint Samples




Given Steps:









 Collect some color paint samples (for free) at a Home Improvement Store (ex. Home Depot, Rona...) 2. Cut out a thin strip from each colour.


- 3. Apply glue onto the strip and paste it onto the clipping end of a clothespin.
- 4. Make sure to paste it onto the clipping part of the clothespin, so that it appears on top of the paint sample.



5. With your clothespins prepared, have another set of the same paint samples to clip them on to.



 Match each clothespin to the correct colour paint sample.



Try with your child:

- Saying the names of the colours: ex. "This is pink, and this is yellow!"
- Talk about how there are shades of colour: ex.
 "This is light green, and this is dark green!"
