

# ALPHABET ACTIVITY

## Finding the Alphabets in my home

### What you need:

- Glue
- Scissors
- Warm Coloured (red, yellow, Pink) Paper
- Blue, Green & Black construction Paper
- Foam Alphabet



### Steps:



1. Cut out each sheet of construction paper in half.

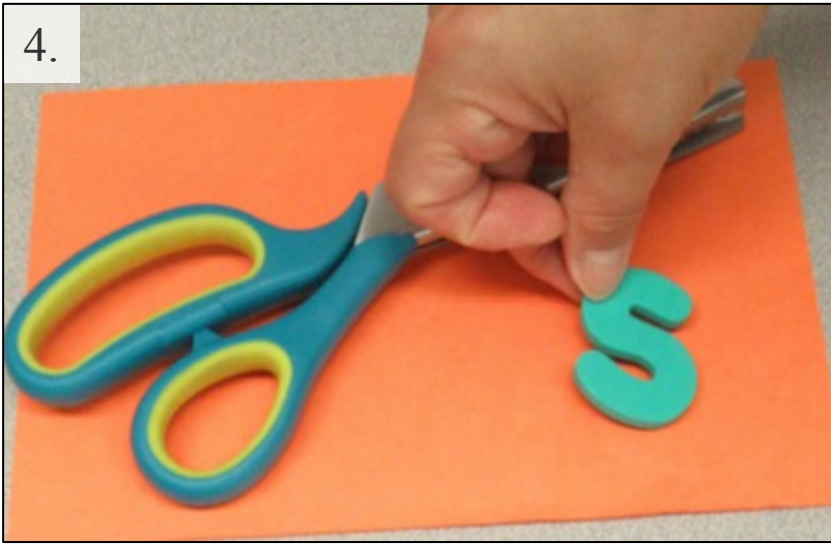


2. Place the papers all out on a flat, wide surface.



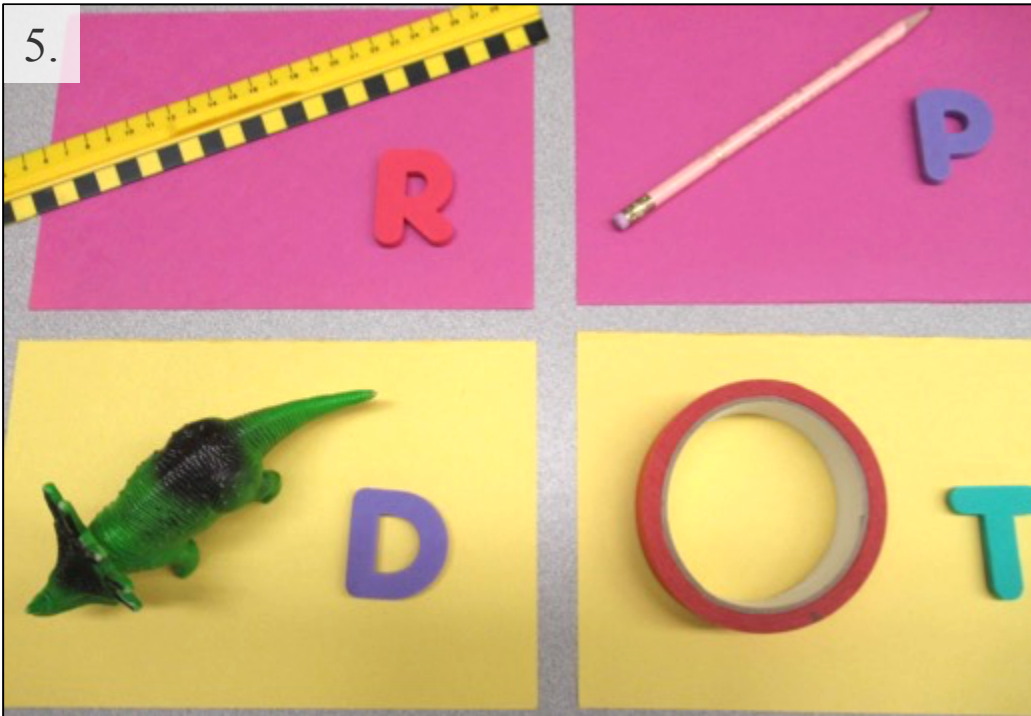
3. Place a foam alphabet on each piece of construction paper. If there are no foam alphabets, use a marker to write the letter.

4. For each letter of the alphabet, find an object in the house that starts with that letter. For example, for “S”, you can find “Scissors”.

5. Do the same for the other letters of the alphabet as well. “R” can be for “Ruler”, and “T” can be for “Tape”.



Try with your child:

- Talk about each letter in the alphabet, and what they sound like.
- Say the name of each item out loud with your child, repeating the first letter sound. Ex. "C-C-Crayon" or "D-D-Dinosaur".
