Firework Painting

What you need:

- Scissors
- White and coloured construction paper
- Tempera Paint
- Paper Plates
- Paper Towel Tube

Steps:

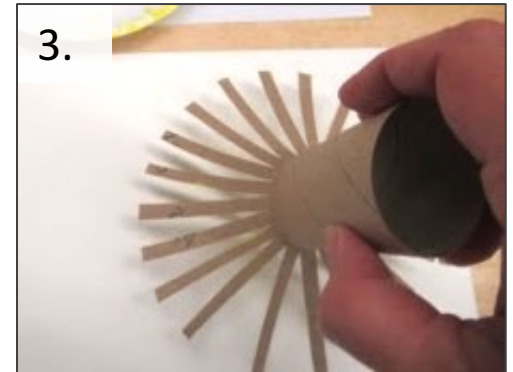
1. Cut in thin strips along the length of the paper towel tube.

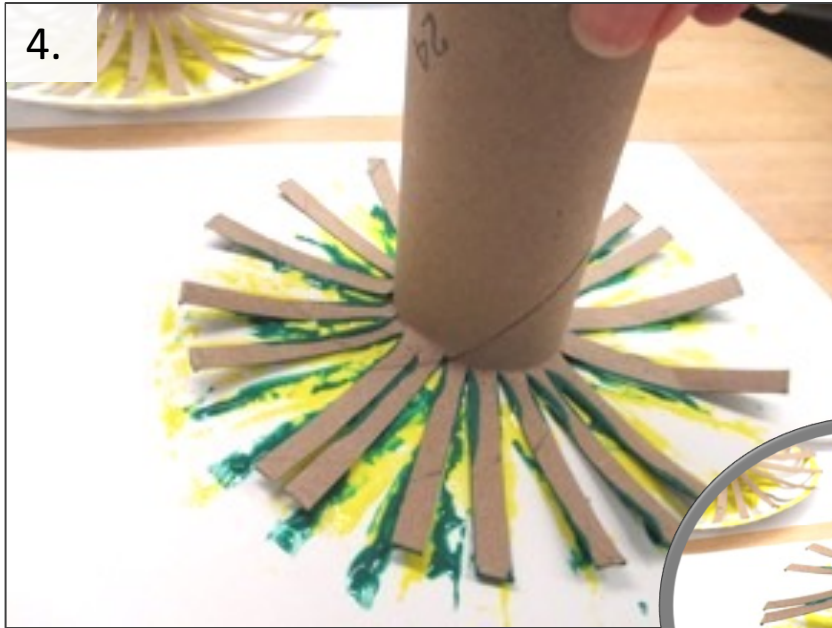

2. Spread out the thin strips and dip them into some tempera paint.
3. Stamp the paper towel tube onto the paper to make a firework shape.

4. Dip the paper towel tube into another color. Then stamp it onto the paper, on top of the first firework shape.

5. Make more firework shapes on the paper. Stamp them on top of each other to make them more colorful.



Fill the paper with colorful fireworks,
just like how the night sky is filled up with fireworks too.

Try this with your child:

- Cut the strips on the tube in different ways. Make it thinner or thicker, longer or shorter. See how the firework shape changes.
