Fizzy Baking Soda Experiment

☐ Steps:



1. Place some baking soda on a tray and pour some water over it.

☐ What you need:

- Baking Soda
- Vinegar
- Water
- Spoon
- Cup
- Tray
- Cookie Cutters
- Bowl





2. Mix the baking soda and the water together.



3. Take the baking soda and water mixture and roll it into a ball.







4,5. Once firm, press the baking soda ball into a cookie cutter to mold it into the shape. Let it dry until firm.





6,7. Place the baking soda shape into a bowl of vinegar and watch as the mixture fizzes and dissolves.
