

# Flower Colour Changing

### Steps:



1. Cut the flower stems so the flower will fit into the plastic cups. Add water to the cups.



2. Add about 10 drops of food colouring to the water in the cups. Stir the food colouring in the water and put one flower in each cup.

### What you need:

- White Carnation (flowers Assorted)
- Food Colouring
- Clear cups
- Scissors (adult only)
