SENSORY ACTIVITY

FLUFFY SLIME



What you need:

- Washable white glue
- Foam Shaving Cream
- Saline Solution for Contact Lenses
- Baking Soda
- Baby Oil
- Food Coloring



Steps:



1. Pour the bottle of glue (225ml) into a plastic bowl.



2. Add a couple drops of food coloring onto the glue.



3. Mix the food coloring and the glue.




4. Add 1-2 cups of shaving cream.



5. Add 1 tablespoon of baking soda.



6. Mix the shaving cream and baking soda with the glue.



7. Add 1 tablespoon of saline solution.



8. Stir until everything is well mixed together.



9. Add a few drops of baby oil and mix again.





10. Knead the playdough with your hands. If the slime is too sticky, then add a little more saline solution.

The slime should be fluffy, stretchy, and flexible, but not too sticky.

** This fun science activity works because mixing glue with saline solution makes it become more solid instead of liquid, and have this new texture. Putting in the shaving cream makes the slime become fluffy. Adding different ingredients to the slime makes it change.
