Fork Painted Shape Monster




☐ What you need:


- Fork
- Acrylic paint, assorted colors
- Googly eyes, varying sizes
- Black sharpie



☐ Steps:









- 1. Create squares, circles, triangles, diamonds with a pen or marker.
- 2. Talk about the shapes with your children: What shapes are they? What do they look like?
- 3. Make a simple set of arms and legs.



4 Use the tines of the fork on the paint to make a furry look.



7. Glue a googly eye in place. Large eyes, multiple smaller eyes, whatever your monster has going on. Glue on the monster's mouth as well.



5. By dipping the fork in a squirt of paint, you can make a monster.




6. Draw a monster mouth on another sheet of white cardstock. Make the lines thick enough to cut out.
