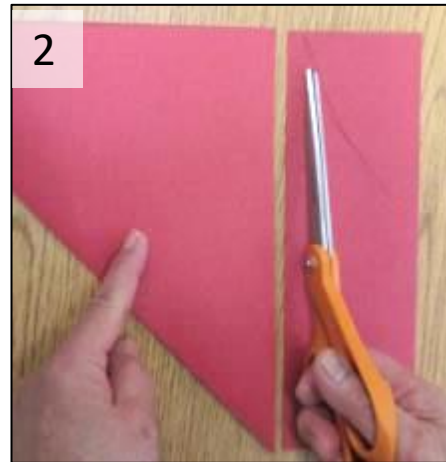
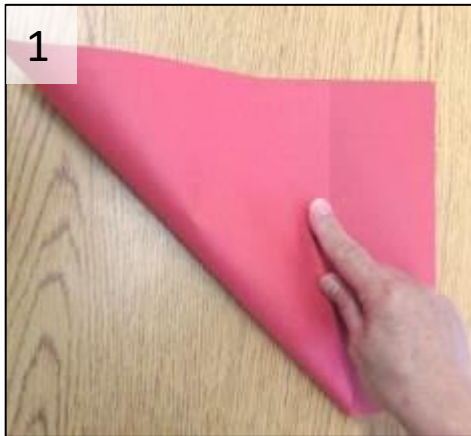


## HEART FLOWERS

### Steps:

### What you need:

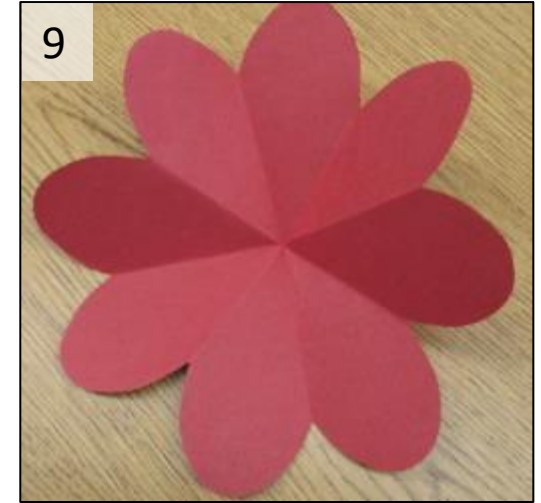
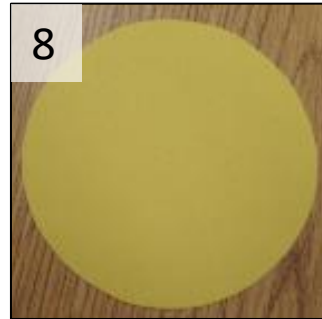
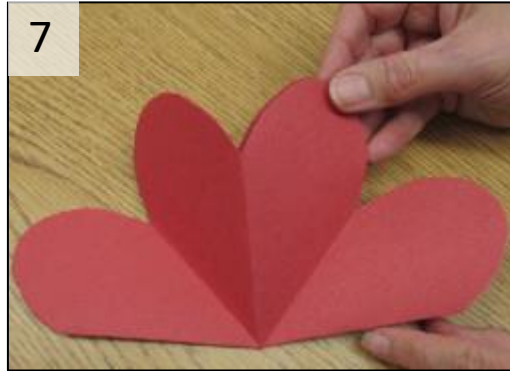
- Markers
- Clothespin
- Glue
- Tape
- Construction Paper (1 Yellow, 1 Green, 1 Red)
- Green Popsicle Stick



1. Fold the bottom left corner of the red construction paper up to the top side of the paper.

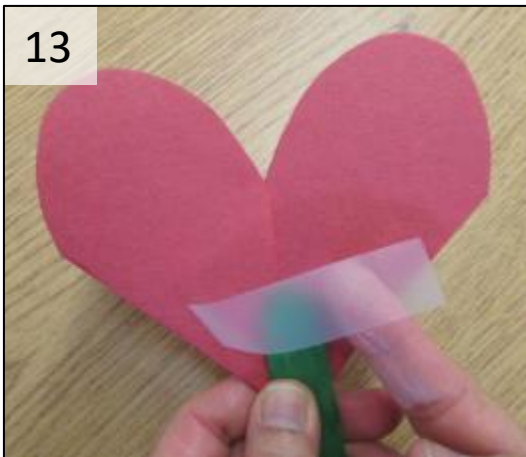
2. Cut along the side of the paper that hasn't been folded to make a folded triangle.

3, 4. Fold up the left and right corners of the folded triangle to the point in the middle.

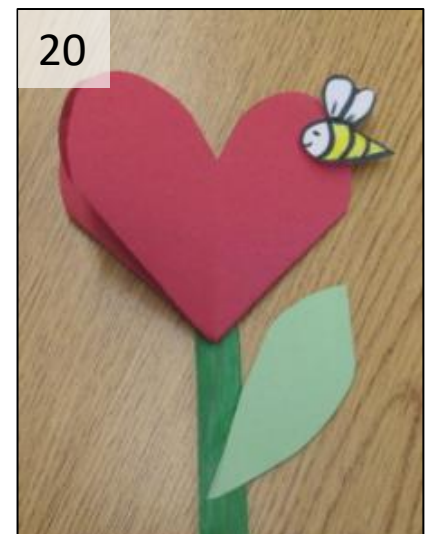
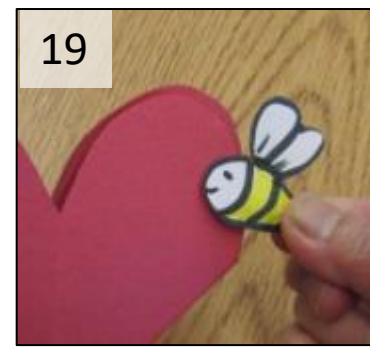
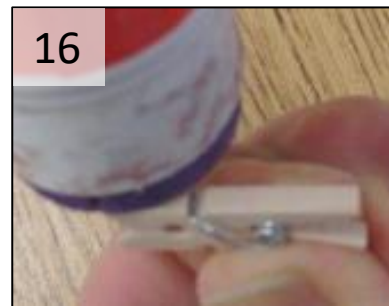
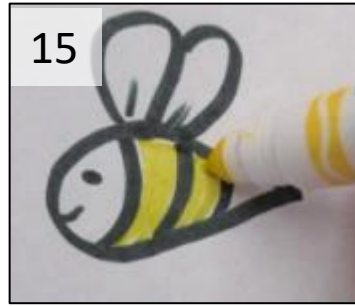


5, 6. Draw a curved line that starts on the left side of the paper and ends on the right. Make sure that the open side of the paper is at the top, then cut along the line.

7, 8, 9. Open up the folded paper to reveal the flower! Then, cut out a yellow circle, small enough to place in the middle of the flower.



10, 11, 12, 13. Paste the yellow circle in the middle of the flower, and if needed, help your child write the message they want onto the yellow circle. Then, fold the paper flower, pushing the left and right side of the paper inwards to form a heart shape. Tape a green popsicle stick in the bottom centre of the heart shape.

14. Cut out a green leaf from the construction paper to attach to the popsicle stick stem of the flower.

15. Using the markers, draw and colour a small bee.  
16, 17, 18, 19, 20. Glue it onto a clothespin and clip your bee onto the folded flower, to keep the heart closed until the heart flower is opened.  
The heart flower is now complete! This is a perfect, heartwarming gift to give to someone you love.
