- 1. Provide group facilitation to youth members in accordance with the guideline from program manual
- 2. Attends ongoing supervision with coordinator for best practice of program delivery services
- 3. Ensures client and program records are maintained and that confidentiality is a priority. Ensures all program documentation is accurate and complete, including follow-up measures at the end of treatment.

- 4. Provides documented summary of the group facilitation process, data collection and data analysis of group outcomes
- 5. Engages in regular, individual or group supervision/consultation sessions with coordinator to provide feedback on program delivery.
- Ensures health and safety standards are maintained.

## WHAT WE REQUIRE IN A CANDIDATE:

- 1. At least 1 year experience in group facilitation
- 2. Certificate and/or training in group facilitation
- 3. At least Two year post secondary

- 5. Knowledge and understanding of trauma-informed practices, feminism, misogyny
