## □ Steps:


## □ What you need:

- White Paper
- Cardboard Box
- Precision Knife
- Colorful Markers
- Glue
- Colorful Sticks










1. Apply glue onto one side of the white paper.


 Place the white paper (glue side down) onto the bottom of the cardboard box. 3. Using a precision knife, cut rows of slits into the bottom of the cardboard box.











4, 5. Using the markers, colour in a rectangle around the outside of each slit. Alternate and use different coloured markers.





6. With your child, match the popsicle stick with the slit according to the colour.



7, 8, 9. Insert the popsicle sticks into the matching coloured slits. Talk about the colours you can see with your child, and experiment with pushing in the popsicle sticks more or less. Talk about how this makes the sticks taller or shorter.

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
