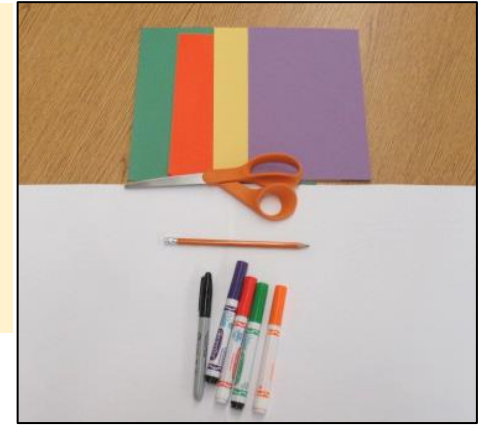


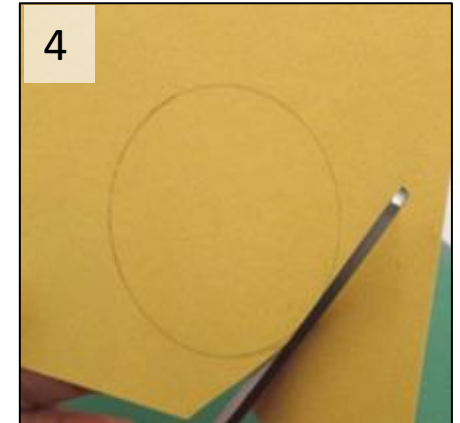
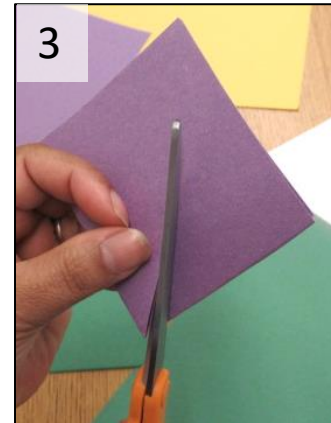
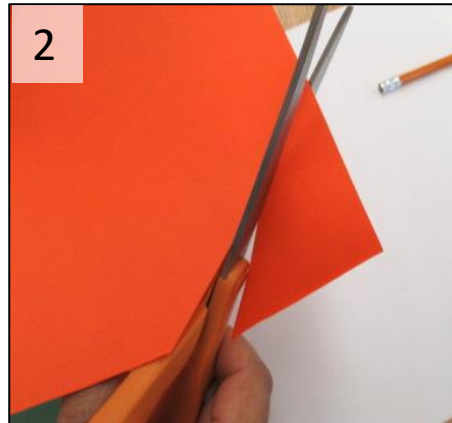
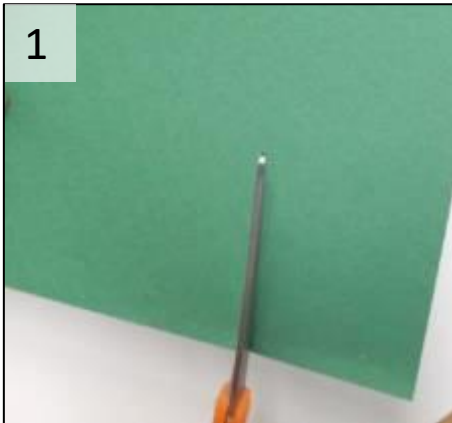
## What you need:

- Pencils & Colorful Markers

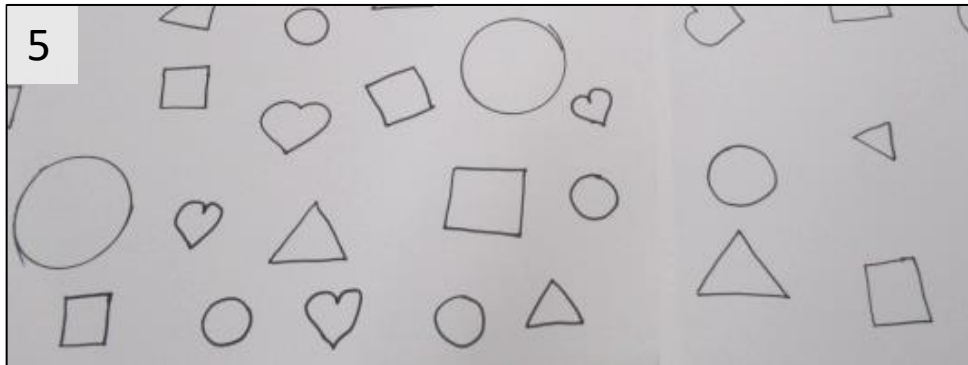


# Shapes and Colours

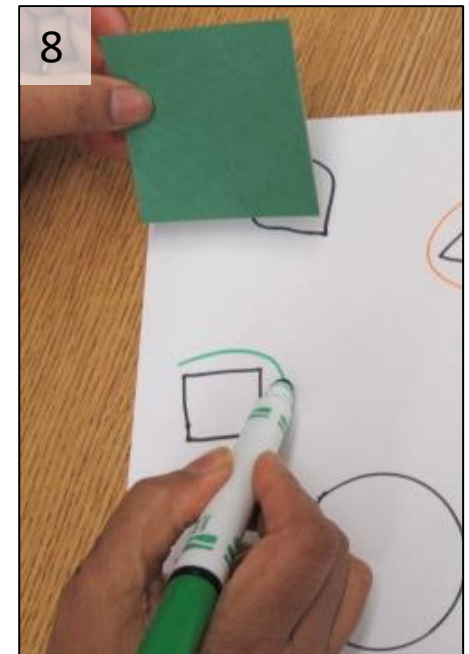
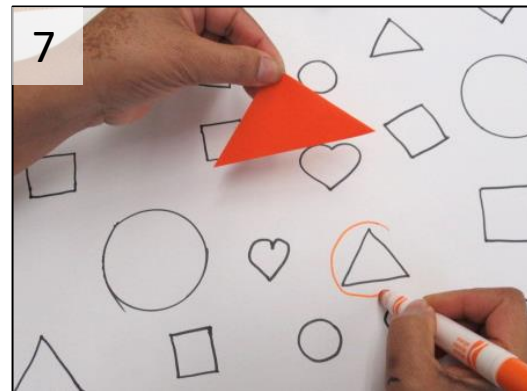
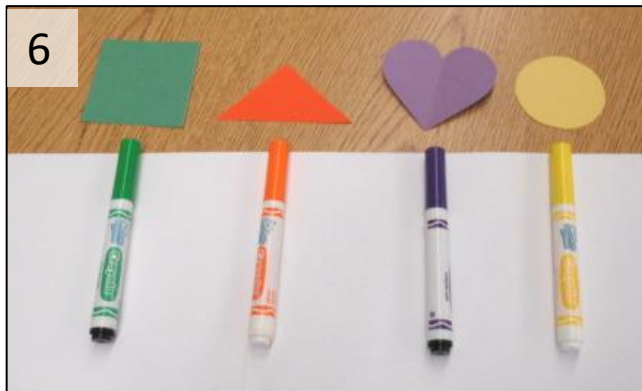
## Steps:



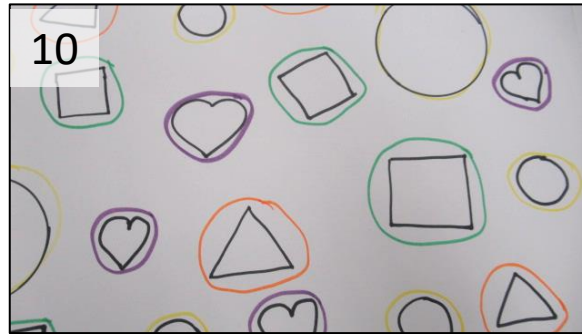
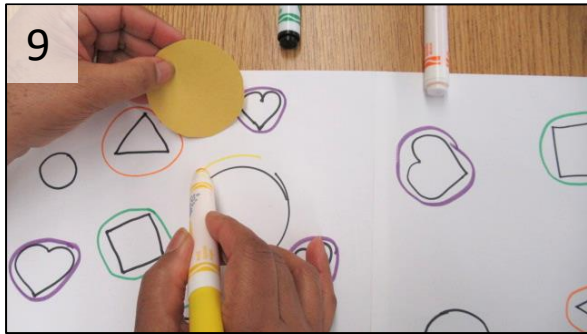
1, 2. Draw and cut out a different shape from each sheet of coloured paper. For example, draw and cut out a square from the green paper, and a circle from the yellow paper.



5. Using a black marker, draw the shapes you've cut from the coloured papers onto a white sheet of paper.



6, 7, 8. With your child, pick out markers that match the colours of the cut out shapes, and then circle the shapes on the white paper with that colour. For example, if the square cutout is green, circle the squares with the green marker.



9, 10, 11. Continue until all of the shapes have been circled, and talk about the shapes and colours with your child.
