

Shaving Foam Art

Steps:

What you need

- Paint (Red, Yellow, Blue)
- Tray
- Construction paper (various colours)
- Wooden Skewer
- Shaving Foam



1, 2, 3. Spray some shaving foam onto the tray. Then, place droplets of the paint here and there on top of the shaving foam. Drag a wooden skewer through the paint droplet-covered shaving foam.



4, 5. Try making patterns of paint on the shaving foam with the skewer or blending them together to create other colours. Try drawing in shapes as well.

6. Once you and your child have finished blending the paint, place a sheet of paper on top of the paint and shaving cream mixture.



7, 8. Peel the paper off of the paint and shaving foam mixture and let it dry. As it dries, the shaving foam will harden and leave a bumpy, rough texture on the paper along with the colours from the paint. Your unique, abstract artwork is complete! You can try making more artworks like this with different coloured construction paper.
