## What you need:

- Toilet Paper Rolls
- Scissors
- Tape/Glue

Snowman

- Felt (red)
- Paper
- Pipe cleaners


## Steps:

- Markers



1,2. Take a toilet paper roll and wrap a sheet of paper around it, gluing the edges down.



3,4 . Bend a pipe cleaner, curling each end and tape them onto opposite sides of one end of the toilet paper roll. This makes the snowman's earmuffs.

5. Using the markers, draw on the snowman's face.
6.Using the scissors, cut out a strip of red felt.

7. Wrap the strip of red felt around the snowman's body, under the face. Tie it around to make the snowman's scarf.
8.Glue two buttons onto the snowman's body.

8. The snowman is now all finished! You and your child can make more snowmen together to create a snowman family.

Try drawing different faces, using different colours, or using paper towel rolls to create snowmen of a variety of sizes!
