Snowstorm in a Jar

What you need:


- Baby Oil
- Glass Jar
- Glitter
- White paint
- Alka-Seltzer

 Pour out some baby oil into a glass jar.

2. Pour out a ½ cup of white paint and a bit of water into a measuring cup. 3. Pour the white paint into the glass jar containing the baby oil.

4. Watch as the paint forms little droplets under the baby oil.
