Snowstorm in a Jar

❑ What you need:

- Baby Oil
- Glass Jar
- Glitter
- White paint
- Alka-Seltzer

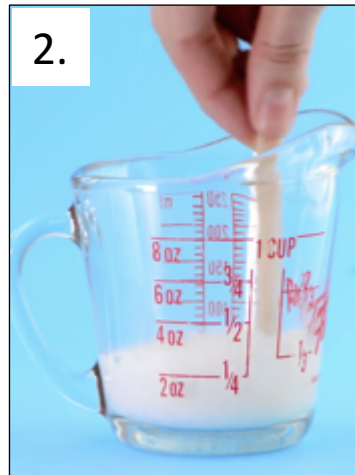
❑ Steps:

1.



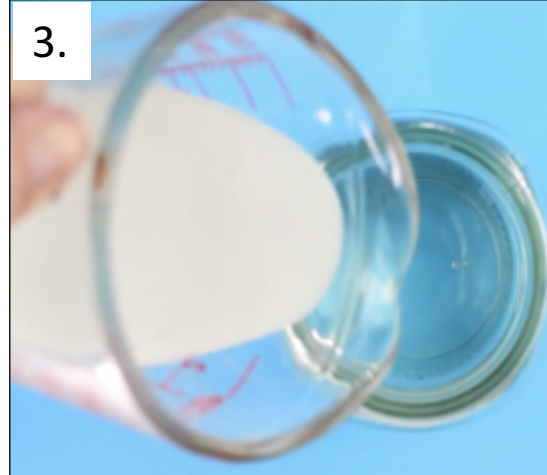
1. Pour out some baby oil into a glass jar.

2. Pour out a $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of white paint and a bit of water into a measuring cup.

3. Pour the white paint into the glass jar containing the baby oil.

4. Watch as the paint forms little droplets under the baby oil.

5. Sprinkle some glitter into the glass jar.

6. Take out a tab of Alka-Seltzer.

7. Break the Alka-Seltzer tab into smaller pieces.

8. Drop the Alka-Seltzer into the jar.



9. As the Alka-Seltzer goes into the jar, the paint and baby oil mixture will fizz and bubble up, splattering white glittery “snow” against the jar, like a “snowstorm”!
