Tens go fish

What you need:

. One deck of cards. Remove all the face cards and the number 10 cards





. You will be left with four cards each of numbers 1-9





To do:

Step1: deal each player five cards. Place the stack of remaining cards face down in the middle of the table. This is the "GO Fish" pile.



before beginning the game, look for pairs of cards in your hand with a sum of 10. Place all pairs with a sum of 10 face up on the table in front of you. Draw from the GO Fish pile to replace the cards so you still have five cards in your hand.





Step2: Go fish, players take turns asking each other for their desired card. However, instead of seeking out pairs of the same card, players want pairs to make the sum of 10. For example, if I hold a 5,3,2,4,9, I might ask for a 5 so I can "make 10".





If a player runs out of cards, he picks two new cards. A player's turn is over when he can no longer make 10. The game is over when there are no more cards, or no more pairs can be made.
